


# INTRODUCTION


Global Context: Rapid digital transformation and sustainability imperatives reshaping information access.

Purpose: To outline Cambodia's efforts, specifically at Cambodia Library, in "futureproofing" its library.

Focus Areas: Strategic digital innovation and sustainable practices.



### CURRENT LANDSCAPE OF LIBRARY




#### Traditional Role:


- Historically, a vital repository of legal, economic, and social science knowledge.
- Extensive physical collections supporting law, economics, business, and public administration.
- Core services: circulation, reference, physical study spaces.

### Current Digital State:


- o Online Public Access Catalogs (OPACs): Implemented for physical resource discovery.
- E-resource Subscriptions: Growing access to online databases, e-journals, and e-books relevant to legal and economic studies.
- Basic Digital Repositories: Initial steps for archiving local research, theses, and dissertations.
- Limited Digitization: Nascent efforts for unique Cambodian legal/economic documents.







### CURRENT LANDSCAPE OF LIBRARY Cont.



### Key Challenges:

- Funding: Budget constraints limit comprehensive e-resource acquisition and advanced infrastructure.
- Infrastructure: Reliable internet and power supply remain hurdles for consistent digital access.
- Digital Literacy: Ongoing need for training for both users and staff in digital resource utilization.
- Policy Gaps: Lack of national standards for digital preservation and data management.
- Human Resources: Shortage of librarians with specialized digital and IT skills



# DIGITAL INNOVATION INITIATIVES

### E-Resource Expansion & Management:

Continuous efforts to expand subscriptions to legal databases (e.g., LexisNexis, Westlaw where accessible), economic journals, and e-books.

Focus on optimizing access and usage through intuitive discovery systems.

Workshops for students and faculty on effective e-resource navigation.

### Development of Digital Repositories:

Strengthening institutional repository for RULE's intellectual output.

Includes academic publications, student theses, research papers in law and economics.

Aim: Enhance visibility of Cambodian scholarship and promote open access.

#### **Digitization Programs:**

Prioritizing digitization of unique Cambodian legal documents, historical economic reports, and valuable print materials.

Objective: Preserve fragile heritage and broaden access to specialized content.

Requires careful planning, adherence to international standards, and specialized equipment.


### Online Services & User Engagement:

Exploring virtual reference desks, online tutorials for legal research, and remote access to library services.

Utilizing university platforms and social media for user engagement and resource promotion.

# SUSTAINABILITY EFFORTS

### **Long-term Preservation of Digital Content:**

- Exploring strategies for digital preservation of legal and economic data.
- Adopting international standards for metadata and file formats.
- Implementing robust backup systems and considering cloud solutions.
- Planning for content migration to prevent obsolescence.

#### **Funding Models & Partnerships:**

- Advocating for increased government and institutional budget allocation.
- Seeking grants and collaborations with international organizations, law firms, and economic institutions.
- Engaging donors for specific digital innovation or preservation projects.

#### **Capacity Building & Training:**

- Continuous professional development for library staff in digital librarianship, legal information management, and IT skills.
- Regular workshops for students and faculty on digital literacy, legal research databases, and academic integrity.

#### **Environmental Sustainability:**

- Promoting energy-efficient practices within the library.
- Encouraging digital resource use to reduce paper consumption.
